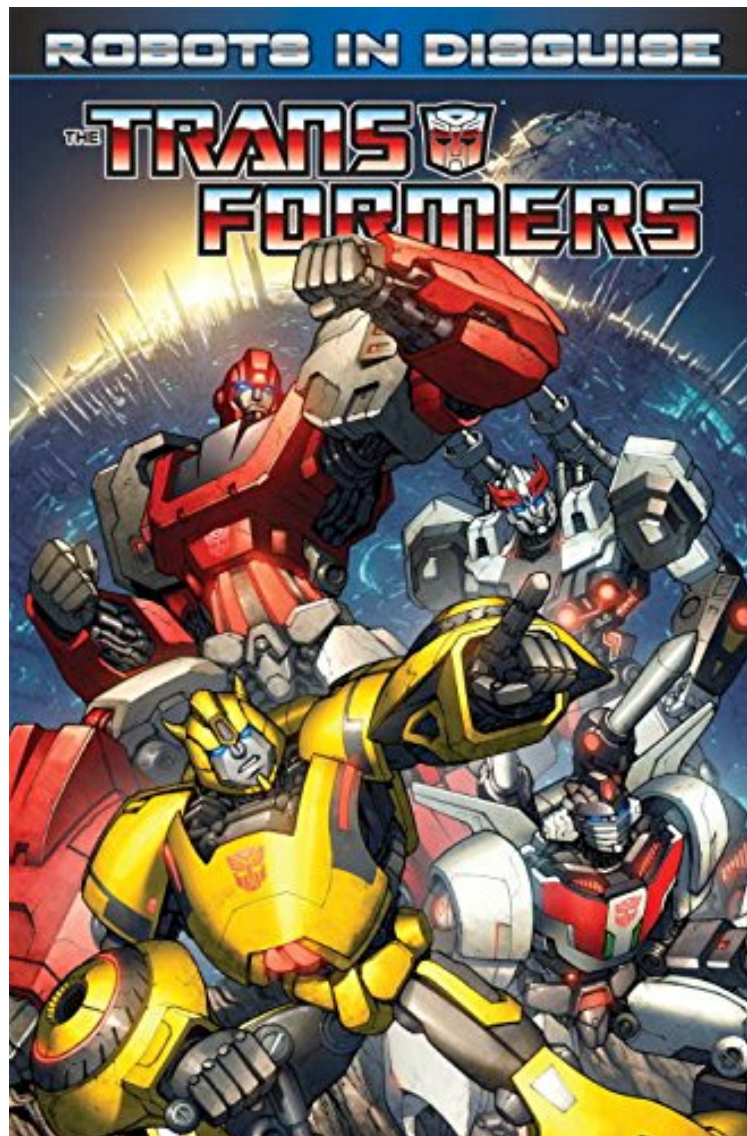

Non-aligned Transformers are returning in droves, the Decepticons are still walking around causing problems, there is an energy crisis and it is clear that Starscream is plotting something. On top of it all, many
